

Hearts in Bloom
Cutting Directions for Large Quilt: 54" X 66"

Finished size: 55" X 60" (8 blocks wide, 10 blocks long, 3" borders)

Materials: 4 yds Dark (including binding) 3 yds Light

Blocks: (40) 6 ½" square of each color

(160) Hearts of each color

(2) Border strips [Dark] 3 ½" X 61"

(2) Border strips [Dark] 3 ½" X 55"

Binding: cut from Dark fabric as per preferred method.

Dark Fabric: Borders: Trim the salvage edge from one side of the fabric. Cut a strip 14" X 65" along this edge [without the salvage].

Cut the strip into (2) 7" X 65" strips. Trim one strip to be 61" long.

The rectangle trimmed off can be used to cut 2 Hearts.

Trim the other strip to be 55" long. The rectangle trimmed off can be used to cut 4 Hearts. Cut each strip in half lengthwise to have (2) strips 3 ½" X 55" and (2) strips 3 ½" X 61".

Blocks: The remaining width will be at least 26" wide. Cut (10) strips 6 ½" by the width of the remaining fabric. Cut (4) 6 ½" squares from each strip for (40) blocks 6 ½" squares.

Hearts: Cut (10) strips 6" by the width of the fabric. Cut each strip into 6" X 4" rectangles. Two Hearts can be cut from each rectangle for a total of 160 Hearts.

Light Fabric: Blocks: Cut (7) strip 6 ½" by the width of the fabric.

Cut each strip into 6 ½" squares for 40 blocks 6 ½" square.

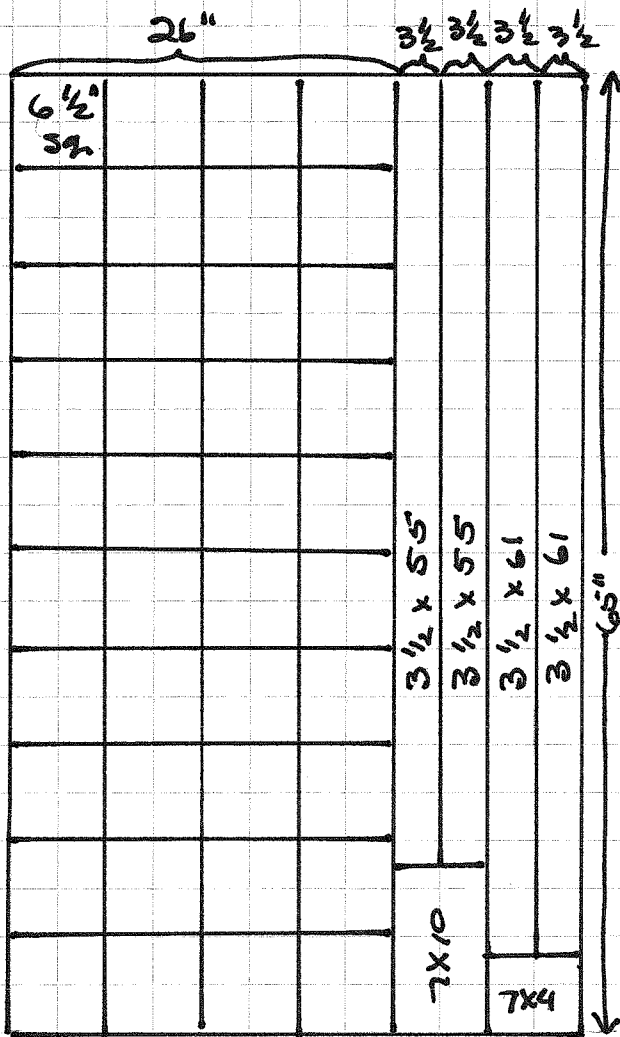
The ends of each strip can be used to cut Hearts.

Hearts: Cut (10) strips 6" by the width of the fabric. Cut each strip into 6" X 4" rectangles. Two Hearts can be cut from each rectangle for a total of 160 Hearts,

The extra rectangles are not needed but can be used to cut Hearts for sample blocks.

Extra fabric is included in this kit.

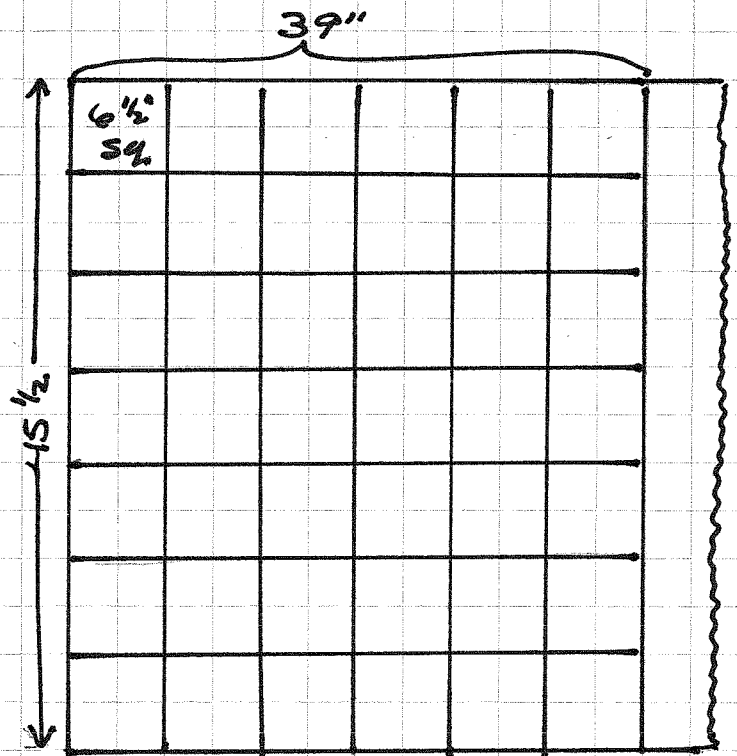

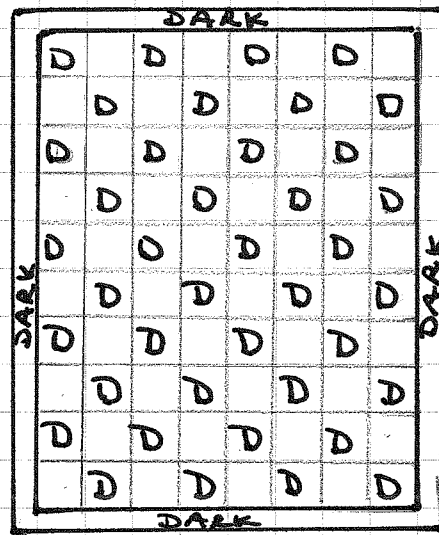
Block & Border Cutting Layout
